December 16, 2019

Present: Susan East, Ann and Larry Lauer, Jane Huelsmeyer, Linda Snider, Stacey Nicholas, Joe Coelho, Melissa Hughes, Kat Buch, Martha Whitney, Carolyn Williams, Pat Creek, Ann Behrens. Mary Price arrived at the end of the meeting.

Jane called the meeting to order at 6:45. Ann Lauer gave the treasurer's report. The October checking balance was \$4,857.31. Expenditures were \$1,816.84. Income totaled \$2,293.22, leaving a net gain for November of \$476.38. The checking balance at the end of November was \$5,333.69. Total assets are \$27,446.70.

Since there was no meeting in November, Ann also gave the treasurer's report for October. The September balance was \$6,926.48. Expenditures totaled \$4,747.48 which includes a \$2,000.00 payment to the cluster show account. Income totaled \$2,678.31, leaving a loss of \$2,069.17. The checking balance at the end of October was \$4,857.31. Total assets were \$26,970.41.

There was no secretary's report for November because there was no meeting. Members were reminded of the slate of officers presented for election. Jane Huelsmeyer reported that Becky Welch had donated \$600 to K-9 connection from her photo sessions in Macomb and Quincy.

Susan East made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Ann Lauer. The meeting was adjourned at 6:59 p.m.
